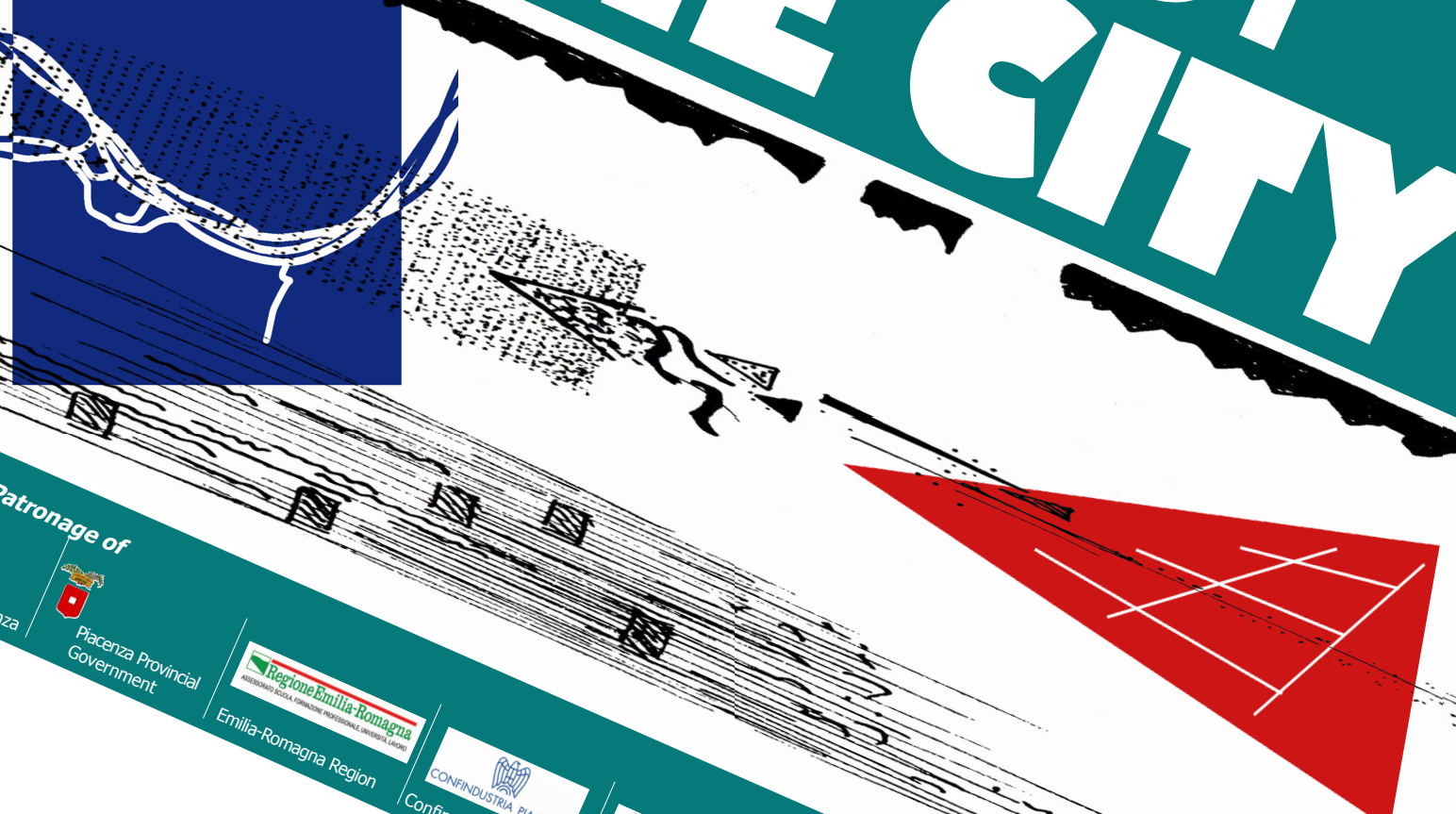
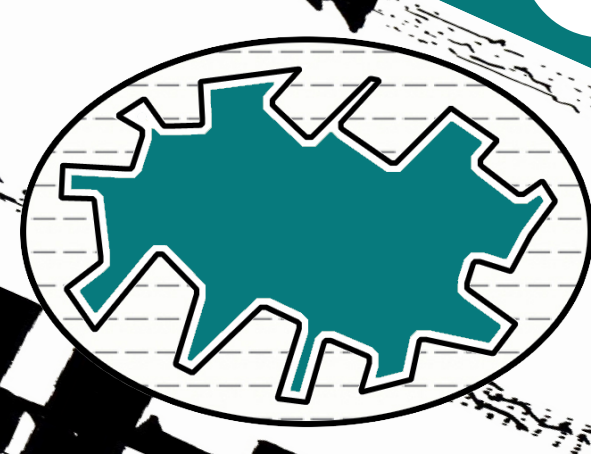

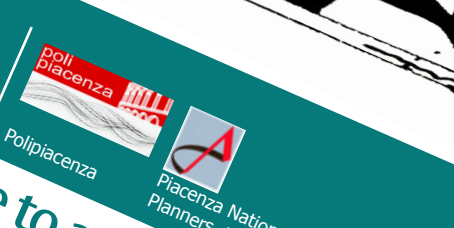

PROGRAM: FROM ECOLOGICAL LANDSCAPE TO ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN
The program of the International Summer School provides:
1 - A daily workshop that applies specific architectural, urban and environmental design issues at different levels of intervention, aimed at the quality and sustainability of the transformation of the occupied space. The design process is conducted through group work, with the constant assistance of tutors and professors.

THE INTERNAL STRUCTURE OF THE WORKSHOP FOCUSES ON:
a - Landscape: large-scale landscape;
b - Urban Space: urban and metropolitan fabrics;
c - Architectural design: architectural elements, supporting lectures and panel discussions on current architectural design issues.
3 - A series of parallel evenings dedicated to the relationship between art and architecture, major transformations of the urban context and in the territory.
5 - Three critical reviews (two mid-term and one final) with the participation of an International Commission.

NATURE IN THE CITY
Reuse sites, regenerate spaces, recuperate potential. The fourth edition of Politecnico di Milano OC Summer School focuses on the critical and problematic issue of the transformation of the contemporary city. Design will be focused on the urban spaces, the proposing forms and functions that renew a balance between artificial and natural. Piacenza is characterized by a strong presence of low density and under-utilized areas, "in-between" areas without a present day use or clearly defined future. By balancing "between growth and de-growth" as an approach to design, the students would identify the relation between the nature and the city referring to the "Common Ground" theme proposed by David Chipperfield in the latest Venice Biennale. We will attempt to reject the simple labels that our society tends to propose (the city "smart" or slow, or on the other hand, the indiscriminate use of technology as the only recognized sustainable models), and instead forge a new path, passing through a complex set of interacting elements models, and in the slogan of EXPO Shanghai 2010 "best city for a better life".

SELECTIONS
The International Summer School will take place from the 2nd to the 20th of September 2013. Participation is open to students at third year of the Bachelor Degree courses and to students students (in the disciplines of Architecture, Design, Engineering and Planning, as well as to PhD research applications received. The application number of 80 members, that will be selected from the two A4 pages) must be received by June 14th, 2013.

Room and board: on request of the organization of the workshop, the organization of the book accommodation at hotels at a cost of € 20,00 per night (bed&breakfast) and daily meals inside the campus. Evening meals are instead included in the registration fee.
